Coming from the New World, the European continent, Asia and Oceania, the colors of white and orange wines swirled even more at the Palais de la Musique et des Congrès on June 11th and 12th during this 24th edition.

The wine estates of the world entered the dance with in particular a first participation from Mexico, a winning date for Japan, celebrations of indigenous grape varieties and beautiful confirmations of medals.

A desire to participate also for the 63 expert judges from the 5 continents who for some had been prevented for 2 years from traveling from South Africa, Australia, Canada or the States. The tempo: 3 series per morning for each judge and 70 wines tasted by expert over the 2 days.

Christophe Caillaud-Joos, Managing Director of Strasbourg Events and Souhire Ehresmann, Director of Organized Events, intend to work even more by supporting these connections from the next edition to be held in April 2023.

Partnerships are consolidated with each edition. 6 students from AIVA (International Academy of Wines in Alsace) participated under the same conditions as the expert judges in the evaluation of the wines in competition. An extremely enriching "in vino" experience.

The students in Sommellerie from the Lycée d'hôtellerie et de Tourisme Alexandre Dumas, supervised by Antoine Woerlé, Meilleur Ouvrier de France des Arts de la Table et du Service, performed flawlessly at the 9 tables of judges over the 2 days of competition.

The collaboration with ANEV, the Association Nationale des Elus du Vin, is renewed and aims to strengthen communication with French wine regions.

The CIVA (Conseil Interprofessionnel des Vins d'Alsace), partner of the Mondial, organized during the closing lunch a presentation of Grands Crus D'Alsace for the greatest pleasure of the students, journalists, judges and permanent representatives of the consular chambers on the Council of Europe.

Everything is in place to start a new score in April 2023 on the occasion of the 25th anniversary of the contest and celebrate the best white wines on the planet. In Strasbourg, of course!
